When the same voters were asked if they would support a ban on selling more than two vaping units and five pod packs at a time and the sale or marketing of vaping products to anyone under 21, 71 percent of those polled said ‘yes’ to the idea, while 20 percent said ‘no.’”

S.F. Supervisors are considering banning sales of vaporizers while allowing the sale of combustible cigarettes to continue.

Instead, we should regulate e-cigarettes, prevent marketing and sales to people under 21 and preserve adult choice.

**A vape ban won't work
and is unfair to adults
trying to switch.
Instead, a ban:**

- Will push vaporizer sales underground and create black markets
- Could encourage many adult vaporizer users to start smoking again. The ban exempts combustible cigarettes and other tobacco products
- Is opposed by the San Francisco Small Business Commission because it will hurt the 700 local small businesses that sell legal vaporizer products

**Effective vape regulation
will prevent youth usage
while preserving adult
choice. The Board of
Supervisors should:**

- Require city permits to sell vaporizers for both brick and mortar and online retailers
- Require point of purchase ID scanners for retail and online age verification to ensure all purchasers are over 21
- Prohibit all bulk sales to stamp out reselling to purchasers under 21
- Prohibit all vape marketing to youth

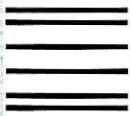
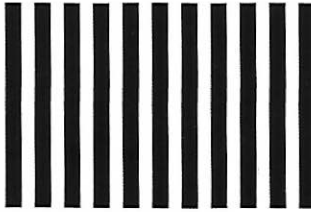
